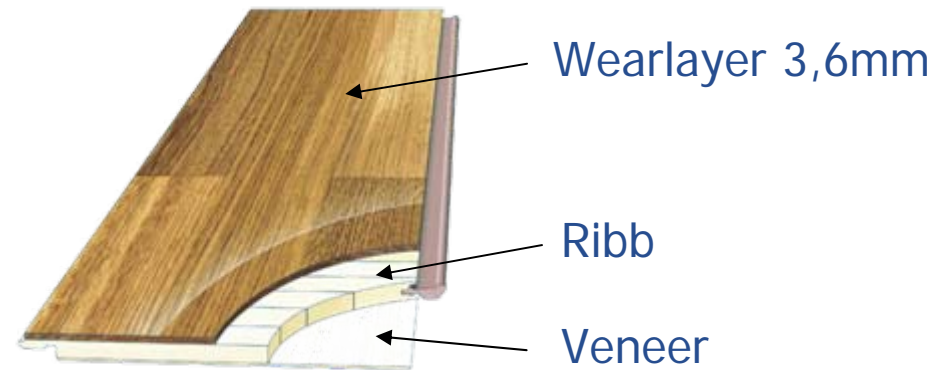

What is Salsa?

- Salsa is the family name for our 14mm 3-strip products
- Core: Ribb (pine, spruce)
- Wearlayer: 3,6mm real wood
- The same proven stable 3-layer principle as all Tarkett wood floors

Why Salsa?

Surface is treated with Proteco or Proteco Natura – the most wear resistant lacquer on the market*

- Proteco is almost twice as wear resistant as most lacquers on the market
- The wear and tear is on the lacquer – not the floor
- Proteco Natura is the most wear resistant mat lacquer on the market – the look of oil but the advantages of lacquer!

Thickness

- 14mm provide a very good stability
- The 3- layer principle provides stability to the floor and minimizes movements while still providing a floating installation – no need to glue down
- The middle rib layer has standing year rings to provide maximum stability

Wearlayer

- 3,6 mm wearlayer allows you to re-sand the floor up to 4-5 times
- Can take a lot of wear and tear and therefore fits most rooms in a home

Why Salsa?

Salsa is easily installed without glue

- Easily installed and also easy to remove (bring along...)
- Available in different locking systems according to customer preference

You can have your 3-strip Salsa in a number of ways

- ½ or full length
- Unfinished, laquer, matt laquer, brushed with matt laquer, stained or heat treated
- Several wood species: Oak, Ash, Cherry, Beech, Walnut, Maple, Merbau, Jatoba, Doussie, Msasa
- Several gradings
